Commercial Member Terms & Conditions 2016

These terms and conditions cover the rights and responsibilities of Energy Sector Security Consortium, Inc. (EnergySec) and the joining entity (the "Member"). By completing the membership application, the Member accepts Membership in EnergySec in accordance with the following terms and conditions.

1. Membership Conditions:

- a. **Commercial Member Benefits:** The Commercial Member shall be entitled to the benefits provided below in section 2. The Member shall be entitled to participate in the meetings of Commercial Members, to receive materials disseminated to Commercial Members by EnergySec, and to other benefits of Commercial Membership as may be determined from time to time by EnergySec.
- b. **Use of Name:** The Commercial Member may publicly disclose that it is a Member of EnergySec, and shall have use of applicable membership logos and other promotional material during the term of its membership. EnergySec shall have the right to include the Member's name in any lists of Members published by EnergySec and to announce that the Member has joined EnergySec.
- c. **Dues:** Unless terminated as provided herein and except as otherwise provided herein, the provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect as to the Members renewing annually upon the Member's payment of dues. Payment will be processed via the original payment method unless notified of a change in payment preference prior to renewal.
- **d. Terms:** A membership term is for one year. An organization's renewal date will be one year from the 1st day of the 1st month after joining (Example: Organizations joining in April will renew on May 1st of the following year). Renewal fees will be invoiced and payable on the renewal date.
- e. **Expenses:** The Member shall bear its own costs and expenses incurred in connection with its Membership in EnergySec, such as travel, employee compensation and incidental expenses.
- f. **Withdrawal by the Member:** The Member may withdraw from Membership in EnergySec at any time upon giving sixty (60) days' written notice (the "Withdrawal Notice") to EnergySec. The Member shall be obligated to pay dues which accrued prior to the Effective Date of Withdrawal. After the Effective Date of Withdrawal, the Member shall not be subject to any agreement.

2. Commercial Member Benefits

- a. <u>Receive recognition</u> as an industry leader in security through the use of the EnergySec Commercial member logo, and listing on EnergySec website and membership materials.
- b. Eligibility to <u>partner with EnergySec on projects and initiatives</u> that improve the security posture of industry.

- f. Membership is organization-wide with no restrictions on the number of participants from each Commercial member organization
- g. Priority access to EnergySec staff.

4. Affiliate Policy

Except for business unit memberships, a Commercial member and its affiliates shall be deemed one member. Affiliate means any legal entity that directly or indirectly controls another entity via beneficial ownership of more than fifty percent (50%) of voting power or equity in another entity ("Control"), or is Controlled by another entity or is under common Control with another entity, so long as such Control exists.
